

# Enter Our Miss Teach Essay Contest!

**Submit your 500 to 1000-word essay on “What One Person Can Do to Make a Difference for Life” and qualify to win valuable scholarship prizes!**

Your essay can be based on the heroic story told by Anne I. Remis in “Miss Teach: Handwritten with Love” or on a person of your own choosing who exemplifies heroic commitment to the cause of life. Prizes will be given in the following categories: Category 1: 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade students; Category 2: High School; and Category 3: College and University students. Adult (non-student) entries will be considered in a separate, non-prize category.

Prize levels start at \$1,000, including a \$500 first prize, and \$250 second and third prizes. Total prize levels may rise depending on sales of “Miss Teach” prior to the entry deadline. All books sold before the entry deadline will be credited toward the scholarship prize fund, whether or not an entry is submitted.

Sales of “Miss Teach” are the main source of funding for the scholarship prize fund. *No purchase is necessary to enter the contest*, but you must register if you wish to receive email reminders of the contest deadline

Sales of “Miss Teach” benefit three great causes. Royalties of 10% go to CP Rochester, a leading non-profit organization in the field of helping children with disabilities. One third (33%) of the remainder goes to the scholarship prize fund, and the rest funds pro-life education programs of the Movement for a Better America.

Single copies of “Miss Teach” can be ordered by sending \$10, plus \$2.00 shipping and handling for a total of \$12.00. Additional copies for classroom or church use ordered at the same time are just \$8.00 each, and we pay postage on bulk orders. All orders are shipped within 24 hours.

Final deadline for entries is: April 30, 2010. Entries will be judged by a veteran panel of journalists, teachers, and editors. Contest winners will be announced on or before May 31, 2010. Decision of the judges will be final. Winning entries will be published on our website, together with essays deserving of honorable mention.

The Movement for a Better America reserves the right to amend the rules of this contest at any time before the final entry date. All entries become the property of MBA, Inc. Requests by the original authors to publish their material elsewhere will be honored, as long as credit is given to The Movement for a Better America.
